- Assist in data release activities, helping ensure data accuracy, completeness, consistency, and compliance with established procedures.
- Create, maintain, and manage Part Numbers (PNs) and associated product information throughout the development lifecycle
- Assist in vehicle configuration activities, helping ensure the correct definition and consistency of configuration data.
- Perform data validation and quality checks under the guidance of senior team members.
- Support data traceability and alignment across different systems and platforms.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams in addressing data-related issues and supporting the timely release of product information.
- Contribute to the continuous improvement of data management and release processes within the automotive development environment.

- Strong attention to detail and accuracy.
